It is well known that most museums' collections include artefacts too numerous for all to be exhibited at the same time. The purpose of the Collections Centre of Amgueddfa Cymru is to undertake custody, curatorial care, management, and conservation of the wide variety of such items in its possession.

While the Centre is accessible to the public by prior appointment, our visit will be specifically structured to appeal to Friends with an interest in fine art. There will be a short introductory talk with coffee/tea being served after which the main speakers will be Nick Thornton, Head of Fine and Contemporary Art, and David Jenkins, Principal Curator Transport who will give a talk about the Department of Industry's ship portraits. The visit will be of approximately two hours' duration.

Those wishing to attend should note that transport to Nantgarw will not be provided, Friends being asked to make their own travel arrangements. Coming from the direction of Cardiff on the A470 one should take the A468 for Parc Nantgarw. A site map is overleaf. Ample free parking is available. Public transport does not serve the immediate locality.
