**The Great Schism – The separation of Eastern and Western Churches.  
An illustrated talk given by the Most Reverend Doctor Barry Morgan**

Put simply, and possibly simplistically, institutional Christianity is comprised of the Roman Catholic Church, Orthodox Churches and Protestant Reformed Churches.

In 1054 AD, centuries of political, language and theological differences culminated in a division of Eastern and Western Christianity. The implications are still apparent to this day.

The Most Rev. Dr Barry Morgan is a native of Gwaun-Cae-Gurwen in the Swansea Valley. He graduated from the University of Cambridge in 1972, and in 1986 was awarded a Doctor of Philosophy from the University of Wales. Ordained in 1972, Barry has held both parish and university posts becoming Bishop of Bangor in 1993, Bishop of Llandaf in 1999, and Archbishop of Wales from 2003 until his retirement in 2017. Barry has served on the Central Committee of the World Council of Churches and is now a Commissioner on the Judicial Appointments Commission for England in Wales, which appoints judges.
