The Campaigns of Margaret Lloyd George

Richard Rhys O'Brien is author of two recent books published by *Y Lolfa*, "*The Woman who Helped Win the War*" and "*The Campaigns of Margaret Lloyd George*". After a career as an international economist and strategist and author Richard has turned to storytelling through songs and biographical studies.



Richard will bring to life the remarkable achievements of Margaret Lloyd George during her time in Downing Street – her multiple welfare campaigns during the First World War and her unique political campaigning during her husband's peace time government. His work draws on the archive of speeches and correspondence left by his Cardiganshire-born grandfather, the Rev. J. T Rhys, Mrs Lloyd George's Private Secretary during her No. 10 years, on the extensive contemporary media coverage of her activities, and from the archives and images in the National Library of Wales and the Museums of Wales.
